

# BATHROOM

## DON'T

- ✗ Use automatic toilet bowl cleaners.
- ✗ Use anti-bacterial products.
- ✗ Put paper towels, tissues, hair, wipes (even ones marked 'flushable'), or feminine products (no tampons) down the toilet.
- ✗ Put anything down the toilet other than natural waste and toilet paper.

## DO

- ✓ Use NON-antibacterial soap.
- ✓ Use biodegradable cleaners (phosphate and chlorine free).
- ✓ Add ½ cup of EcoEthic Septic Treatment to toilet monthly.
- ✓ Conserve water to avoid overloading the septic system.

- Septic systems need bacteria to properly function, thus anti-bacterial products are not good for the system.
- Your system can only handle the volume of water and waste from the number of people it was designed for!  
$$\# \text{ of Bedrooms} \times 2 \text{ People} = \text{Capacity}$$
- The toilet, sink and shower are connected to the septic tank, a system of tanks that allows waste to filter 'slowly' into the ground.
